

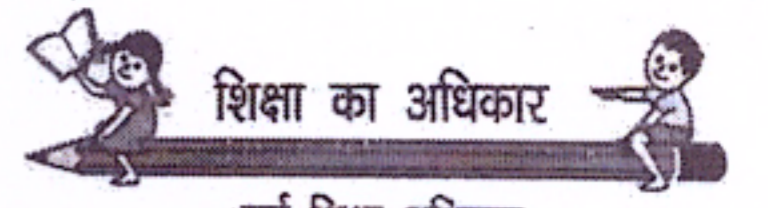

विषय: पूर्व से संचालित विद्यालयों को पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालयों के रूप में उच्चीकृत किये जाने हेतु ऑनलाइन आवेदन किये जाने के सम्बन्ध में।

महोदय,

उपर्युक्त विषय के सम्बन्ध में अवगत कराना है कि भारत सरकार द्वारा वित्त पोषित पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय योजना के अन्तर्गत सम्पूर्ण देश में केन्द्र/राज्य सरकार, केन्द्रीय विद्यालय, नवोदय विद्यालय, लोकल बॉडीज द्वारा संचालित विद्यालयों में से 14,500 विद्यालयों को पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय के रूप में उच्चीकृत किया जाना है, जिसके अन्तर्गत प्रत्येक विकासखण्ड (शहरी/ग्रामीण) में 02-02 परिषदीय विद्यालयों का चयन करते हुये पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय के रूप में उच्चीकृत किया जायेगा। यहाँ यह भी अवगत कराना है कि प्रथम चरण में देश के 6,448 विद्यालयों को पी0एम0श्री विद्यालयों के रूप में चयनित किया गया है, जिसके सापेक्ष प्रदेश के 928 परिषदीय विद्यालयों को प्रथम चरण में पी0एम0श्री विद्यालयों के रूप में चयनित किया जा चुका है।

पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालयों के संदर्भ में भारत सरकार के अर्द्धशासकीय पत्र संख्या-1-7/2023-आई0एस0.19, दिनांक 31 जुलाई, 2023 (छायाप्रति संलग्न) द्वारा द्वितीय चरण हेतु विद्यालयों के चयन सम्बन्धित निम्नवत् दिशा-निर्देश निर्गत किये गये हैं :-

- द्वितीय चरण के रूप में विद्यालयों का चयन पूर्व निर्गत दिशा-निर्देश संख्या-नि0का0/स0शि0/पी0एम0श्री/8132/2022-23, दिनांक 02 दिसम्बर, 2022 (छायाप्रति संलग्न) को ध्यान में रखते हुये ऑनलाइन पोर्टल <https://pmschrischools.education.gov.in> के द्वारा "चैलेन्ज मैथेड" के माध्यम से विद्यालय स्तर से सम्पन्न किया जायेगा। विद्यालय स्तर से आवेदन हेतु दिनांक 01.08.2023 से दिनांक 21.08.2023 की समयावधि निर्धारित की गयी है।
- विद्यालयों की पात्रता एवं चिन्हांकन का आधार यू-डायस+ पर उपलब्ध आंकड़ें होंगे। अतः यह आवश्यक है कि विद्यालय स्तर पर यू-डायस+ आंकड़ों को अद्यावधिक कर लिया जाय।
- विद्यालयों के आवेदन के पश्चात् बैचमार्क विद्यालयों का सत्यापन जनपद स्तर पर सुनिश्चित किया जायेगा, जिस हेतु दिनांक 31.08.2023 की अन्तिम तिथि निर्धारित की गयी है।

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4. विद्यालयों द्वारा आवेदन के पश्चात् जनपद एवं विकासखण्ड स्तर पर सत्यापन के दौरान इस बात का ध्यान विशेष रूप से रखा जाय कि विद्यालय में निर्माण योग्य अतिरिक्त भू-स्थल उपलब्ध हो एवं विद्यालय भौतिक रूप से आदर्श स्थिति में हो। जनपद स्तर से सत्यापनोपरान्त प्रस्तावित विद्यालयों में अनुपयुक्त एवं अपात्र विद्यालयों का चयन कदापि न किया जाय। यदि पूर्व की भांति इस बार भी किसी भी प्रकार के अपात्र विद्यालयों को जनपद स्तर से प्रस्तावित किया गया तो उक्त दशा में सम्बन्धित के विरुद्ध कठोर कार्यवाही की जायेगी।
5. पी0एम0श्री विद्यालयों हेतु आवेदन हेतु यूजर मैनुअल को पृथक से संलग्न किया जा रहा है। आदेशों का अनुपालन समयबद्ध रूप से एवं कड़ाई के साथ सुनिश्चित किया जाये।

Dear Sir / Madam,

As you are aware that the Cabinet has approved a new centrally sponsored PM SHRI (PM ScHools for Rising India) scheme on 07th Sep 2022 that aims to establish more than 14,500 schools across India with comprehensive interventions to promote transformation in equity, access, quality, and inclusion. The online portal (<https://pmschrischools.education.gov.in>) of PM SHRI schools has been launched on 03.11.2022. The first phase of selection process through transparent challenge method has already been completed dated 28.03.2023. A total number of 6,448 schools have been selected in the 1st phase of selection process as PM SHRI Schools.

2. The selection of schools under PM SHRI Scheme for second cycle will be done through a transparent challenge method wherein Schools will self-apply on the online portal. A pool of eligible schools will be identified based on minimum benchmarks through UDISE+ data. These schools will compete in challenge method to fulfill certain criteria, and their fulfillment will be certified through physical inspection by States/UTs/KVS/NVS.

3. States/UTs/KVS/NVS are requested to kindly update the UDISE+ data pertaining to the minimum benchmarks so that they can compete in the challenge method of selection process. Further, it is requested to ensure adequate number of secondary/ Senior Secondary Schools compete in the challenge method during the second phase of selection so as to maximize the reach of the PM SHRI Scheme.

4. The second phase of selection process will commence from 01.08.2023. The Online Challenge portal will remain open for application, verification and approval for Schools/District/State/UT/MoE as per the tentative schedule below:

5. Selection of PM SHRI schools is a time bound process and it needs to be completed within the specified timeline. State Nodal Officers (SNOs) may work out the various needs and the preparatory work at the ground level for better coordination and monitoring of PM SHRI Scheme. The success of the PM SHRI scheme will depend upon the co-operation and co-ordination of all the States/UTs/KVS/NVS. Development in this regard may be conveyed to this office at the earliest.

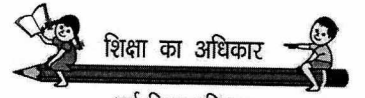

उपर्युक्त विषय के सम्बन्ध में अवगत कराना है कि भारत सरकार द्वारा वित्त पोषित पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय योजना के अन्तर्गत सम्पूर्ण देश में केन्द्र/राज्य सरकार, केन्द्रीय विद्यालय, नवोदय विद्यालय, लोकल बॉडीज द्वारा संचालित विद्यालयों में से 14,500 विद्यालयों को पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय के रूप में उच्चीकृत किया जाना है, जिसके अन्तर्गत प्रत्येक विकासखण्ड (शहरी/ग्रामीण) में 02-02 परिषदीय विद्यालयों का चयन करते हुये पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय के रूप में उच्चीकृत किया जायेगा। केन्द्र सरकार द्वारा प्रस्तावित पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालयों के संदर्भ में भारत सरकार के अर्द्धशासकीय पत्र संख्या-21-1/2021-आई0एस0.8/आई0एस0-19 दिनांक 15 नवम्बर, 2022 (छायाप्रति संलग्न) द्वारा ऑनलाइन आवेदन के सम्बन्ध में दिशा-निर्देश निर्गत किये गये हैं। पी0एम0श्री0 विद्यालयों के सम्बन्ध में निम्न बिन्दुओं पर आपका ध्यान आकर्षित करते हुये अवगत कराना है कि :-

पी0एम0श्री विद्यालयों की विशेषताएं :-

1. नई शिक्षा नीति-2020 की अवधारणा के अनुरूप पी0एम0श्री विद्यालयों के अन्तर्गत उच्च गुणवत्ता की शिक्षा को समानता व न्याय संगत एवं आनन्दमय वातावरण में प्रदान की जा सकेगी। जहाँ पर बच्चों को उनकी दक्षताओं के अनुरूप चाइल्ड पैडागॉजी आधारित पाठ्यक्रम से शिक्षण कार्य संचालित किया जायेगा।
2. यह विद्यालय उच्च गुणवत्ता की शिक्षा एवं बेहतर शैक्षणिक परिवेश के साथ-साथ अपने क्षेत्र के अन्य विद्यालयों के लिये भी आदर्श विद्यालय के रूप में परिभाषित होंगे।
3. इन विद्यालयों को हरित ऊर्जा से समृद्ध विद्यालयों के रूप में उच्चीकृत किया जायेगा। जहाँ पर रेन वाटर हार्वेस्टिंग, सौर ऊर्जा, ठोस एवं द्रव्य अपशिष्ट, जैविक खेती, प्लास्टिक मुक्त इत्यादि अवधारणाओं को विकसित किया जायेगा।

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4. ये विद्यालय तमाम आधुनिक अवस्थापना सुविधाओं यथा—कम्प्यूटर लैब, साइंस लैब, गणित लैब, समृद्ध पुस्तकालय इत्यादि से सुसज्जित किये जायेंगे।
5. इन विद्यालयों में अपनायी जाने वाली चाइल्ड पैडागॉजी आधुनिक रूप से प्रयोगात्मक, समेकित, खेल आधारित, खोज आधारित, जिज्ञासा आधारित, चर्चा आधारित होगी।
6. यहाँ प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी के कक्षा अनुरूप दक्षताओं हेतु निर्धारित लर्निंग आउटकम पर विशेष ध्यान दिया जायेगा।
7. इन विद्यालयों में बच्चों के कौशल विकास पर भी ध्यान दिया जायेगा ताकि बच्चों के क्षमता संवर्द्धन के साथ-साथ रोजगारपरक सम्भावनाओं के लिए भी तैयार किया जा सकेगा।
8. इन विद्यालयों के लिए विद्यालय गुणवत्ता एवं मूल्यांकन फ्रेमवर्क (School Quality Assessment Framework) भी विकसित किया जायेगा, जिसके माध्यम से बच्चों की दक्षता एवं शिक्षण व्यवस्था की गुणवत्ता का मूल्यांकन किया जा सकेगा।

विद्यालयों का चयन एवं मूल्यांकन :- पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालयों के लिए भारत सरकार द्वारा उत्कृष्ट अवस्थापना सुविधाओं एवं छात्र नामांकन संख्या को यू-डायस में उपलब्ध आंकड़ों के आधार पर मूल्यांकित करते हुये विद्यालयों का चयन किया जा चुका है, जो कि पी0एम0 श्री पोर्टल पर "बैंचमार्क स्कूल" के रूप में दिख रहे हैं। इन्हीं विद्यालयों में से मूल्यांकन के पश्चात् सर्वश्रेष्ठ विद्यालयों को पी0एम0श्री विद्यालय के रूप में उच्चीकृत किये जाने हेतु प्रस्तावित किया जा सकेगा।

डिस्ट्रिक्ट नोडल ऑफिसर की नियुक्ति :- प्रत्येक जनपद में सम्बन्धित जिला बेसिक शिक्षा अधिकारी को डिस्ट्रिक्ट नोडल ऑफिसर (डी0एन0ओ0) के रूप में राज्य स्तर से नामित किया जा चुका है, जिसके अन्तर्गत सम्बन्धित जिला बेसिक शिक्षा अधिकारी का नाम, सी0यू0जी0 मोबाइल नम्बर एवं आधिकारिक ई-मेल आई0डी0 को डी0एन0ओ0 के रूप में रजिस्टर्ड किया गया है। जनपद का सम्बन्धित सी0यू0जी0 मोबाइल नम्बर के माध्यम से लॉगिन हेतु सम्बन्धित मोबाइल नम्बर/ई-मेल आई0डी0 पर प्राप्त ओ0टी0पी0 के माध्यम से पी0एम0 श्री पोर्टल पर लॉगिन किया जा सकेगा। समस्त जनपदों हेतु नियुक्त डी0एन0ओ0 की सूची पृथक से संलग्न (संलग्नक-2) की जा रही है। यदि किसी जनपद को लॉगिन में दिक्कत होती है तो राज्य स्तर पर श्री राजीव नयन गुप्ता, राज्य सलाहकार, मो0 नं0-9415581966 पर सम्पर्क किया जा सकेगा।

पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय हेतु विद्यालयों को आमंत्रित किया जाना :- जनपद लॉगिन पर दिख रहे समस्त बैंचमार्क विद्यालयों को डी0एन0ओ0 द्वारा पी0एम0 श्री विद्यालय में आवेदन हेतु प्रतिभाग किये जाने के सम्बन्ध में अनिवार्य रूप से ऑनलाइन आमंत्रित किया जायेगा, जिसके पश्चात् सम्बन्धित प्रधानाध्यापक/अध्यापक को रजिस्टर्ड ई-मेल एवं रजिस्टर्ड मोबाइल नम्बर पर एस0एम0एस0 के माध्यम से एक लिंक प्राप्त होगा। उक्त लिंक पर विद्यालय के यू0डायस कोड को अंकित करते हुये एवं रजिस्टर्ड मोबाइल नम्बर एवं ई-मेल आई0डी0 पर प्राप्त ओ0टी0पी0 के द्वारा लॉगिन किया जा सकेगा। उक्त विद्यालय लॉगिन के अन्तर्गत संलग्नक-1 के आधार पर निर्धारित 07 खण्ड के अन्तर्गत कुल 57 प्रश्न

सम्बन्धित बैंचमार्क विद्यालयों के प्रधानाध्यापक/सहायक अध्यापक का तकनीकी प्रशिक्षण :- बैंचमार्क विद्यालयों को ऑनलाइन किये जाने से पूर्व बैंचमार्क विद्यालयों के सम्बन्धित अध्यापकों/प्रधानाध्यापकों का तकनीकी क्षमता संवर्द्धन कैस्केड मोड में अनिवार्य रूप से किया जायेगा, जिसके अन्तर्गत सर्वप्रथम समस्त ए0आर0पी0/एस0आर0जी0 अध्यापकों को जनपद स्तर पर प्रशिक्षित किया जायेगा। तत्पश्चात् ए0आर0पी0/एस0आर0जी0 अध्यापक द्वारा विकासखण्ड स्तर पर प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने के साथ-साथ सम्बन्धित अध्यापकों द्वारा विद्यालय स्तर पर भी आवेदन ऑनलाइन किये जाने हेतु सहयोग प्रदान किया जायेगा। आयोजित प्रशिक्षण में निम्न 03 बिन्दुओं पर विशेष रूप से ध्यान दिया जायेगा :-



It will nurture students in a way that they become engaged, productive, and contributing citizens for building an equitable, inclusive, and plural society as envisaged by the National Education Policy 2020. More than 20 lakh students are expected to be the direct beneficiaries of the scheme. The scheme will also promote understanding of various dimensions of Quality of school education and inform Policy, Practice and Implementation. The learning from these schools will be scaled up to other schools in the country. The Scheme is proposed to be implemented over a period of 5 years w.e.f. 2022-23 to 2026-27.

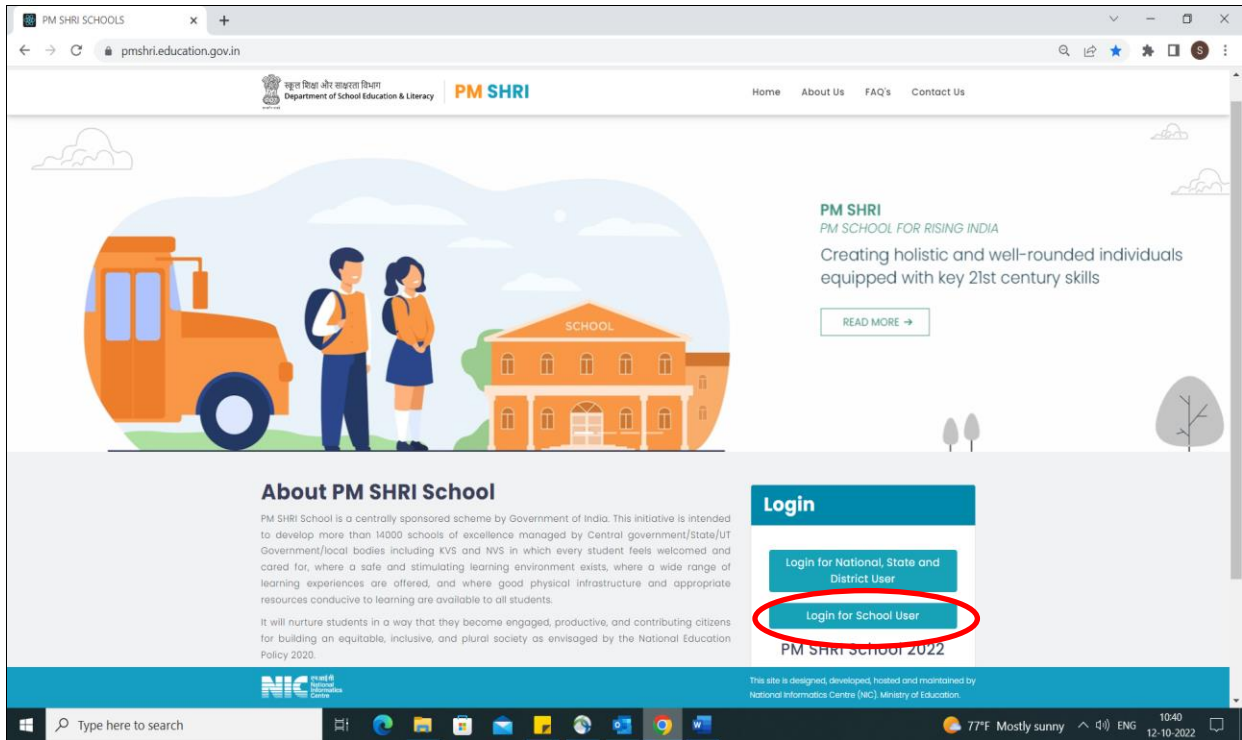

4.1 School User Login

The URL for PM SHRI School is : <https://pmsfri.educationschools.gov.in/>.

School User can login either using UDISE+ Code or through Registered Mobile No. The School User need to go to the Login for School User area in the home page of PM SHRI web link. The Link will be shared by National User/State User for the Minimum Benchmark Schools based on the UDISE+ data.

The Elementary schools (Class 1-5/1-8) & the Secondary/ Sr. Secondary Schools (Class1-10/1-12/6-10/6-12) managed by Centre/State/UT Governments/local self-governments having UDISE+ code would be considered for selection under the Scheme.



Once the School user, select the “School User” option, it will redirect the user to the below screen, where they need to put the UDISE+ Code or the Registered Mobile Number in PM SHRI School Portal along with the text of the captcha in their respective text area. OTP will be sent to the registered mobile number for login, press the LOGIN button as shown in the circle. ***Entry of captcha field is mandatory due to security reasons.***

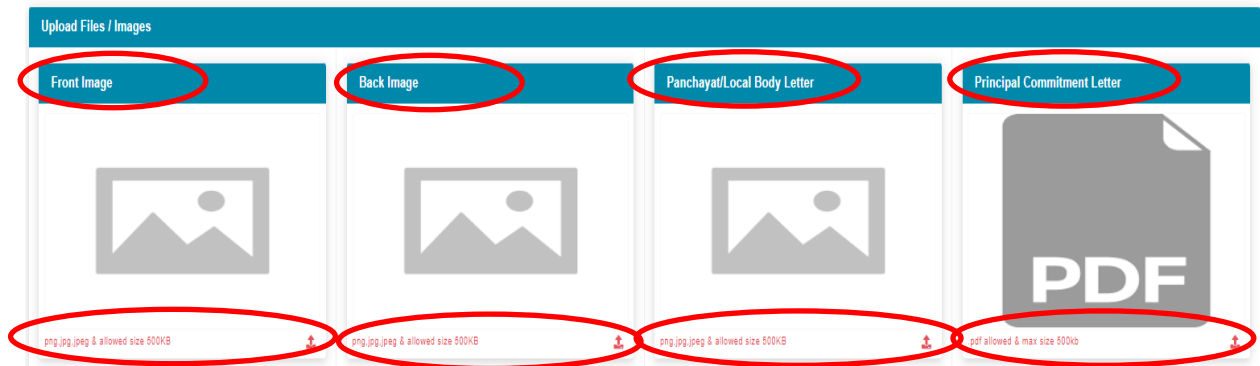

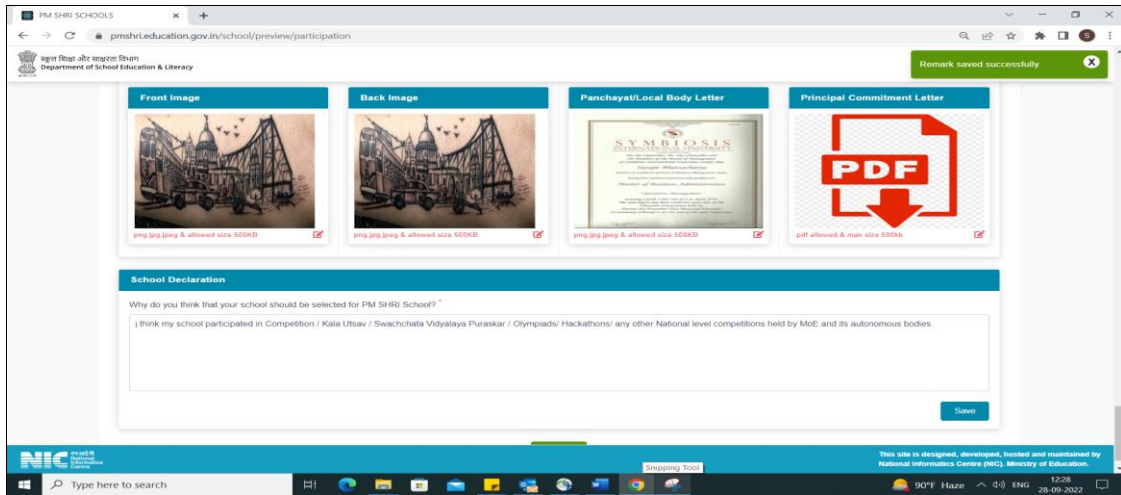

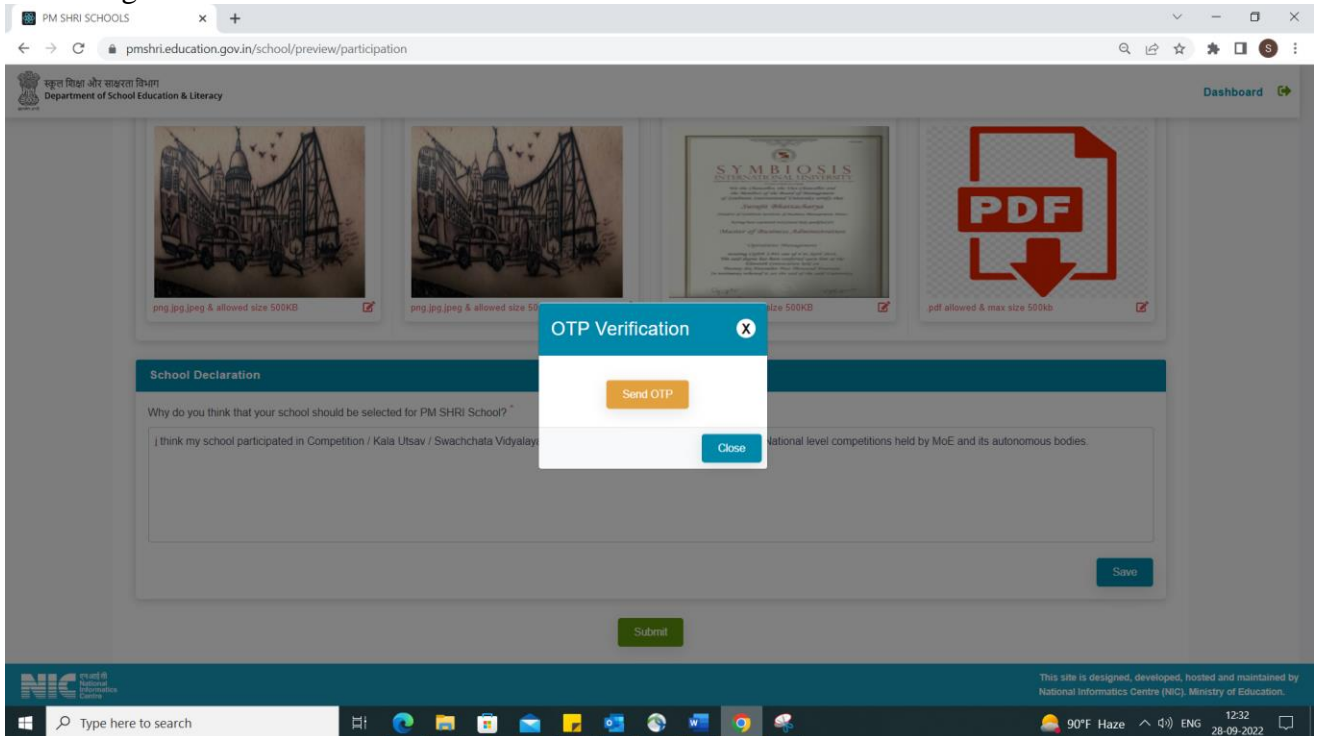
